

What scan features are available in the Professional Mode of the Epson scan driver?

For the professional or advanced amateur, the Epson Scan professional mode allows the most sophisticated control in pre-scanning.

Did You Know?

The Epson Scan professional mode offers these options, which vary with specific scanners:

- 1 Settings: Save a profile with specific settings
- 2 Original: Select what type of original document is being scanned
- 3 Destination: Target size, color, and resolution
- 4 Adjustments: Pre-scan adjustments for:
 - a Auto exposure—Optimizes the exposure by automatically setting the gamma, highlight, and shadow settings
 - b Histogram adjustment—Optimizes image with color channel and gray balance adjustments
 - c Tone correction—Optimizes image with the four most common tone correction curves
 - d Image adjustment—Optimizes image by adjusting brightness, contrast, saturation, and color balance
 - e Color palette—Allows adjustment of mid-tone levels, such as skin tones
 - f Unsharp Mask Filter—Sharpens image
 - g Descreening—Smooths images scanned from newspaper or magazines
 - h Color Restoration—Restores like-new color to faded or discolored photos, negatives or slides
 - i Backlight Correction—Adjusts the overall brightness and contrast of heavily backlit images
 - j Dust Removal—Removes dust from slides or negatives
 - k Digital ICE™—Removes stubborn dust or scratchmarks from color images
